PROGRAM CYCLE BEGINS

Our giving year is split into two halves: January 1st – June 30th and July 1st – December 31st. We prepare to send your donation to the field at the completion of the half in which you gave.

SPLASH INDIA

You're helping bring clean water to people in India with our implementing partner, Splash.

WHY INDIA?

While India's economy continues to grow rapidly, hundreds of millions of people across the country still face significant challenges. In Kolkata, where we work with Splash, water is widely available, but often contaminated. Kolkata's municipal water system provides water access to 85% of the population, but the system is decades old. Leaks along the pipeline further compromise water quality. Access is lower in schools, and many with access still have poor water quality.

Splash's ultrafiltration systems remove 99.99% of bacteria and viruses from source water. Clean water is distributed to drinking stations and handwashing stations in schools. Splash also invests in hygiene education, training teachers and mobilizing students to engage in and promote good hygiene practices. Once a project is complete, Splash continues to provide support, while gradually transitioning ownership to the school.
